Class 1a Equissage Pulse Senior British Novice First Round

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. DRAWN ORDER

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members

a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2018 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round

Qualifying period: 1 st May - 30th April inclusive.

Prizes: 1st £50.00, 2nd £40.00, 3rd £30.00, 4th £20.00, 5th £20.00,

Class 1b Senior 90cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. DRAWN ORDER

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6.

Class 2 Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m. DRAWN ORDER

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2017 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1 st May-30th April inclusive.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Class 3 Equitop® Senior Newcomers First Round

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m. DRAWN ORDER

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify- in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1 st January 2016, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Rule 102.16, British Showjumping Hind Boot rule for Boots / Leg Protection applies to this class.

Qualifies for: Senior Newcomers Second Round.

Qualifying period: The Senior Newcomers Second Round qualifying period for 2021/2022 (2022 second rounds and finals) is 1 May '21- 30 April '22 (subject to revision). The Senior Newcomers Second Round qualifying period for 2022/2023 (2023 second rounds and finals) is 1 May '22- 30 April '23 (subject to revision).

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off. in at least four Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in a Senior Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). To obtain a double clear qualification, even if the horse is the only clear round, it must jump a jump-off round and jump clear to gain a double clear round. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Class 4 Senior 1.15m Open for Lizzy Edwards Memorial Cup

Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m. DRAWN ORDER

Open to all registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Those riders not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2021 will be eligible to qualify for the National 1.15m Members Cup Final.

Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualification period: 1 st June-31 st May.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/ rider combination. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round)).

Prizes: 1st £150.00, 2nd £100.00, 3rd £80.00, 4th £50.00, 5th £40.00, 6th £30.00

Entry Fee = £30.00

Class 5 Senior Foxhunter - First Round /1.20m Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m. DRAWN ORDER

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

• Foxhunter:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify- in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2015, irrespective of points.

Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round qualifying period for the 2022 second rounds is 1 May '21 - 30 April '22 (subject to revision).

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2022 are not eligible for qualification to the 2023 Championship.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

• 1.20m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Prizes: 1st £150.00, 2nd £100.00, 3rd £80.00, 4th £50.00, 5th £40.00, 6th £30.00

1. The Show Organisers reserve the right to refuse entries without assigning a reason.
2. The Show Organisers have the right to cancel any part, or whole, of the show.
3. No unauthorised person shall enter the Show or collecting rings.
4. The Judge's decision is final. All objections must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of completion of judging of the class involved. A deposit of £50 must accompany the objection which will be returned if the objection is upheld by the Jury of Appeal.
5. Correct and safe dress must be worn at all times. Protective headgear must be worn when mounted on any part of the Show Ground. It is the duty of riders, in the interest of their safety, to ensure that their headgear provides proper protection, is correctly fitted and remains in place.
6. All owners and riders (where applicable, parents and guardians) of horses/ponies competing in any jumping event shall be deemed to be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the British Show Jumping.
7. Prize money to be collected on the Show day from the Treasurer's Office.
8. The Show Organisers reserve the right to alter ring allocation or timing of classes as may be necessary. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be on time for classes.
9. The Rules and By-Laws of the Vale of Glamorgan Agricultural Society must be strictly adhered to by all owners/riders or horses/ponies competing in any event.
10. Admission passes will be sent to exhibitors who enter online by 1st August 2022.
There will be no refund on admission charges paid on the gate
